



Dark Mark Arm Warmers Pattern & Chart

This pattern is written in the round for working in magic loop. I am sure you could convert it to work with dpns but since I don't use dpns, I haven't done it. I wrote this pattern then knit it once and it hasn't been tested further than the one knit. You will need less than one ball of each of the yarns but as for an exact amount I didn't measure.

Supplies: 1 ball Caron Simply Soft in Dark Sage
1 ball Caron Simply Soft in Black
Size US 6 circulars with 40" cable for magic loop
Darning needle for weaving in ends

Gauge: 6 sts + 7 rows = 1 inch

Left Arm:

Starting with the black yarn, cast on 40 stitches and divide on two needles and join for magic loop.

Round 1 - 6: Work in K2, P2 ribbing

Change to green yarn

Round 7-8: Work in K2, P2 ribbing

Work in stockinette for 8 rows then start chart. The chart is worked on the first 20 stitches, the second needle carries the last 20 sts and will be knit in green only as the Dark Mark is only on the inside of the left arm. Work blank spaces in green and Xs in black. Since you are working colorwork in the round I recommend working this inside out and making sure you carefully carry your yarn back and forth (twisting the carried yarn into the working yarn is very helpful). If you experience issues with this then break the black yarn at the end of each chart row then rejoin on the next round when needed.

Knit next 26 rounds in green

Thumb Gusset:

Round 1: K16, KFB, K1, KFB, K1, K20

Round 2: K16, KFB, K3, KFB, K1, K20

Round 3: K16, KFB, K5, KFB, K1, K20

Round 4: K16, KFB, K7, KFB, K1, K20

Round 5: K16, put next 11 sts on a stitch holder or scrap yarn, K20

Knit 6 rounds

Knit 1 rounds of ribbing in green: (K2, P2) x4, K2, P3, (K2, P2) to end

Knit 4 rounds of ribbing in black: (K2, P2) x4, K2, P3, (K2, P2) to end

Bind off

Thumb:

Put 11 sts from holder on needles and pick up one stitch in gap
Knit 1 rounds green
Switch to black and knit 1 round
K1, P1 ribbing for 3 rounds
Bind off.
Weave in all those ends.

Right Arm:

Starting with the black yarn, cast on 40 stitches and divide on two needles and join for magic loop.
Round 1 - 6: Work in K2, P2 ribbing
Change to green yarn
Round 7-8: Work in K2, P2 ribbing
Work in stockinette for 77 rows (approx. 11.5")

Thumb Gusset:

Round 1: K7 KFB, K1, KFB, K1, K30
Round 2: K7 KFB, K3, KFB, K1, K30
Round 3: K7 KFB, K5, KFB, K1, K30
Round 4: K7 KFB, K7, KFB, K1, K30
Round 5: K7, put next 11 sts on a stitch holder or scrap yarn, K30

Knit 6 rounds

Knit 1 rounds of ribbing in green: (K2, P2) x4, K2, P3, (K2, P2) to end
Knit 4 rounds of ribbing in black: (K2, P2) x4, K2, P3, (K2, P2) to end
Bind off

Thumb:

Put 11 sts from holder on needles and pick up one stitch in gap
Knit 1 rounds green
Switch to black and knit 1 round
K1, P1 ribbing for 3 rounds
Bind off.
Weave in ends.
